**Feasts and Celebrations**

**August 6th – Transfiguration of the Lord (1st Century).** Tradition says that Mt. Tabor was the site of the Transfiguration during which Christ showed his disciples the splendor of his beauty. The Lord appeared radiant in the company of Moses and Elijah, and a voice said, *“This is my beloved son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him”* (Matthew 17:5).

**August 14th – St. Maximilian Mary Kolbe (1941).** A Polish Franciscan, St. Maximilian was arrested by the Nazis in 1941 and imprisoned at Auschwitz. When the jailers chose ten people to execute as punishment for an escape attempt, he substituted himself for a man with a family. He and nine others were stripped, starved and killed by lethal injection.

**August 15th – Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary.** The Assumption celebrates Mary’s being taken up into Heaven body and soul at the end of her life. Although already a common belief, it was declared a dogma of our faith in 1950 by Pope Pius XII.

**Diakon Community Services to Distribute Farm Market Vouchers**

Farm market vouchers will be distributed on Sunday, July 23rd after all masses in St. Casimir Hall. Applicants must turn 60 before Dec. 31 of this year and be a Schuylkill county resident (please bring proof of county residency). Income guidelines for eligibility are \$26,973 for a single-person household and \$36,482 for a two-person household. Proxies are needed if you are picking up the checks for someone else (four proxies max an individual).

**ONLY ONE SET OF CHECKS IS DISTRIBUTED TO ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS EACH YEAR.**

**Is the Mass in the Bible?**

The first Mass is the Last Supper, which is recorded in all four Gospels. In keeping with what Jesus commanded his apostles: *“Do this in memory of me”* (Luke 22:19), the Mass continued to be offered after Jesus’ Resurrection and Ascension—before the New Testament was written. In his letter to the Corinthians, St. Paul describes the correct way to offer the Mass. He reminds them, *“For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you will proclaim the death of the Lord until he comes”* (1 Corinthians 11:26).

In the more literal sense, virtually all the prayers and responses are based on verses found in the Bible. For example: *“The Lord be with you”* (Ruth 2:4); *“Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to those on whom his favor rests”* (Luke 2:14); *“Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord”* (Mark 11:9-10). The Mass is a re-presentation of the sacrifice of the cross (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, #1366).

**Make Distractions a Plus in Prayer**

There is no better way to stay close to God than through prayer. Yet when we become distracted during our prayer, we can become discouraged and give up. Try these ideas for turning distractions into blessings: **Gently return.** Start your prayer by placing yourself in the presence of God. When you wander, gently bring yourself back. Avoid shaking yourself like a wet dog. **Develop the discipline of recall.** St. Frances de Sales said, *“When your mind wanders or gives way to distractions, gently recall it and place it once more close to its Divine Master. If you should do nothing else but repeat this during the whole time of prayer, your hour would be very well spent and you would perform a spiritual exercise most acceptable to God.”*

**Make the distraction part of your prayer.** If you start thinking about people and events unrelated to your prayer, pray about them and then return to the original subject of your prayer. **Pray out loud.** When distractions overwhelm you, pray out loud.
