Be Meek, Not Weak

Meekness is often mistaken for weakness, but in fact, nothing could be further from the truth. Being "meek of heart" means being in control of your emotions rather than letting them control you. Today, pray for the courage to be meek of heart.

How Can I Resist Temptation?

There is only one effective way to resist temptation and that is to say "no." But that is easier said than done. Try these ideas for help:

Make a list of what most often leads you into sin. Do you have friends who love to gossip? Do you drink too much with coworkers? Do you spend too much money at the mall? Write your list down and make it complete. Then decide to reject each item on the list.

Practice saying "no" when you are alone. Say it out loud if you have to. Don't offer explanations. Just make it a "no." "I don't do that." "That's not me." Remove yourself from temptation. In the Old Testament story of Joseph,

In the Old Testament story of Joseph his boss's wife *"looked at him with longing"* and followed him around but Joseph *"would not agree to lie with her or even be near her"* (Genesis 39:10). Avoid the gossiping friends, go straight home from work, stay away from the mall.

There is nothing more important than avoiding sin.
