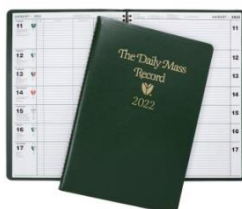
Annual Father Ciszek Mass

Special Voluntary Collection for the Fire Victims, Maui, Hawaii Collection Totally Voluntary

We have all been made aware of the deadly wildfire that swept the town of Lahaina, Maui, Hawaii. Sadly, the death toll stands at over 100 persons, with other persons still missing. Adding to the tragedy is the almost complete destruction of the town. But God works in mysterious ways even in these tragic events. The parish church of Maria Lanakila, an historic Catholic Church, was left unscathed amidst the destruction of the rest of the town. Maria Lankila is translated as Our Lady of Victory. The pastor, Father Kuriakose Nadooparambil, who was permitted to enter the fire area to visit the church, reported that not even the flowers in the church were wilted or singed. There was only a covering of ash on the pews. The parish rectory was also spared but the parish school, convent and hall were destroyed. Despite this "miracle," the parish and town face the immediate need to provide food and shelter for thousands left homeless and the future challenge to rebuild.

Four Tools for Spreading the Good News

Before He ascended, Jesus told His disciples, "Go...make disciples of all nations" (Matthew 28:19). We are all called to preach the Gospel, sometimes by words, but always by the holiness of our lives. Jesus gave us four must-haves for this task:

Peace: The confidence that all things, even our greatest sufferings, will be for our good is peace. Living a Gospel-centered life brings peace and sets us apart in what we choose: music, recreation, dress. These choices are counter-cultural and testify to our faith. Be at peace: our security is in the Truth, not others' opinions of us.

Simplicity: We can't give what we don't have. To give Christ to others, we must make room for Him in our own hearts. For example, buy only what's necessary and limit time on social media. Frequent the Sacraments and Mass. Pray daily.

Charity: Jesus uses us to communicate His love to others. In addition to acts of mercy for the poor, charity requires treating others with dignity, respect, patience, and kindness – even when it's challenging.

Joy: We experience joy when we receive God's love. This means keeping our hearts open to accepting the Good News, not giving into bitterness and resentment, reminding ourselves of the ways God has shown His love for us. Don't keep it to yourself. Tell others.

Roomful of Friends Learning about the saints is a like walking into a room full of strangers. You scan the faces looking for a friendly one who beckons you over. Scan the saintly faces until you find one with whom you would like to become friends. "Only the one who can see hope in death can also lead a life of hope."
