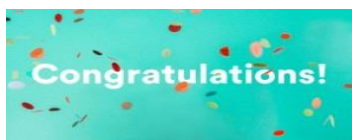

### God Waits for Our “Yes”

God loves us and wants us to be happy with Him in Heaven forever, but He won't force Himself on us. Out of respect for our free will, God asks that we cooperate with His grace to save us, but leaves it up to us to say, “Yes!” **Cultivate your faith.** The better we know our Catholic Faith the easier it is to know how to live it. The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* summarizes all major teachings of the Catholic Church. Read an article in it each day and learn a new term from the glossary weekly. Then, there will be no guessing about what Catholics believe. **Keep your conscience in shape.** A well-formed conscience signals us when a choice is virtuous (good) or sinful (bad). Review what the Ten Commandments and the Beatitudes require. Meditate on the examples of Jesus and Mary in the Gospels and how your behavior compares. **Stay close to the Sacraments.** Through the Sacraments we directly encounter Christ. Attend Confession monthly and Mass at least weekly. This is the best way to stay close to God and His Heart. **Perform Works of Mercy.** God uses these opportunities to conform us more fully to Christ. Find ways to serve your parish in time, resources, or gifts. It is Jesus who ultimately receives our gift (Matthew 25:40).

**Why do Catholics Light Prayer Candles?** Ancient Jews kept a light perpetually burning near the Ark of the Covenant to show reverence for the presence of God. In a similar way, the lit candle symbolizes for us Christ's presence, recalling that he said, “*I am the light of the world*” (John 8:12).

Votive candles in church symbolize prayer intentions others have offered to God. Lighting a candle is also a way of expressing our desire to remain present to God after we have left the church.

**A Little Reminder For Cemetery Lot Owners** in order to keep bringing all our Parish Cemeteries in line with the guidelines and regulations of the Diocese the following will still be enforced: all bricks, fine & crushed stone, plants, fresh & plastic flowers not in containers, fences, borders of all types will be removed & discarded immediately due to the fact that they cause a problem for maintenance of your lot. Again, anything that interferes with the mowing & trimming of grass will be removed at the family’s expense. Containers should not interfere with the care of the cemetery grounds. If they do, the containers will be removed immediately. No planting of flowers, trees, or shrubs allowed. Plastic flowers must be in containers also.

**We are asking that all Christmas flowers be removed from cemetery lots.**

**Is the Mass in the Bible?**

The first Mass is the Last Supper, which is recorded in all four Gospels. In keeping with what Jesus commanded his apostles: “*Do this in memory of me*” (Luke 22:19), the Mass continued to be offered after Jesus’ Resurrection and Ascension—before the New Testament was written. In his letter to the Corinthians, St. Paul describes the correct way to offer the Mass. He reminds them, “*For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you will proclaim the death of the Lord until he comes*” (1 Corinthians 11:26).

In the more literal sense, virtually all the prayers and responses are based on verses found in the Bible. For example: “*The Lord be with you*” (Ruth 2:4); “*Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to those on whom his favor rests*” (Luke 2:14); “*Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord*” (Mark 11:9-10). The Mass is a re-presentation of the sacrifice of the cross (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, #1366).
